This *Citizens for Educational Freedom* Voter's Guide is offered to voters in both Primary and General elections. Our goal is to inform citizens as to where their candidates for public office stand on the issue of freedom of educational choice for all parents of elementary and secondary school-aged children.

The Following Questions Were Asked of Candidates for Office in Missouri:

1. Do you support the fundamental right of parents to choose the kind of education that their children receive?
2. If yes, do you support educational reform legislation to allow parents to spend their fair share of tax dollars collected for education at the schools of their choice in the form of scholarships, whether for public or private school enrollment?
3. Do you support legislation to authorize a tax deduction or tax credit for donations for scholarships from private foundations?

Missouri candidates for national, statewide, and district offices who responded to our questionnaire are listed below, along with their party affiliation and their position on school choice. Those who failed to respond are not included in this Voter's Guide and are presumed to be opposed to parental choice in education.

Key: FOR - in favor of school choice for all parents
AGAINST - opposed to school choice for parents

CON - Constitution
DEM - Democrat
LIB - Libertarian
REP - Republican
