

# 2010 Missouri House of Representatives and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions Endorsed by CEF

**HB 1240** --- Sponsor: Davis, Cynthia L. --- CoSponsor: Wallace, Maynard  
Authorizes a state income tax deduction for tuition costs for any dependent of a resident taxpayer enrolled in any elementary or secondary school or postsecondary education institution in this state.

**HB 1296** --- Sponsor: Lampe, Sara --- CoSponsor: Roorda, Jeff  
Changes the laws regarding the identification, assessment, and education of children with autism spectrum disorder.

**HB 1504** --- Sponsor: Schaaf, Robert  
Expands eligibility for the Missouri Returning Heroes' Education Act scholarship and specifies that homeschooled students must receive the same financial aid consideration as non-homeschooled students.

**HB 1552** --- Sponsor: Schoeller, Shane --- CoSponsor: Zerr, Anne  
Allows public school students to attend a public school district other than the school district of his or her residence under specified conditions.

**HJR 62** --- Sponsor: McGhee, Mike  
Proposes a constitutional amendment guaranteeing a citizen's right to pray and worship on public property and reaffirming a citizen's right to choose any or no religion.

**SB 603** --- Sponsor: Mayer, Robert  
Creates procedures for open enrollment of public school students across school district boundary lines.

**SB 631** --- Sponsor: Cunningham, Jane  
Creates the Amy Hestir Student Protection Act.

**SB 654** --- Sponsor: Crowell, Jason  
Creates the Missouri Special Needs Scholarship Tax Credit Program.

**SB 672** --- Sponsor: Cunningham, Jane  
Revises the conditions under which school districts may suspend or terminate teacher and administrator contracts.

**SB 788** --- Sponsor: Lembke, Jim  
Establishes the "Students First Interscholastic Athletics Act" to allow each student of high school age the opportunity to seek to participate in interscholastic athletics.

**SJR 31** --- Sponsor: Scott, Delbert  
Proposes a constitutional amendment reaffirming a citizen's right to free expression of religion.
